# THE BIG LEAF COLLECTION

Saturday 6th November

Can you help on Saturday 6th November for an hour between 10am and 1pm to collect up all of the year's fallen leaves in St Alphege churchyard?

In previous years over 150 black bags of leaves have been collected, all of which have been recycled on a local set of allotments.

The quantity of leaves that are collected up is in direct proportion to the number of volunteers who turn up on the day!

There are tasks to suit all ages, and families with children are especially welcome to attend.

The children generally have great fun playing with the leaves!

We have lots of plastic rakes, brooms, bags etc.

Refreshments are provided for all ages.
