This Lent, we are drawing on themes and insights from the book Lent and Easter for Everyone by Tom Wright, a New Testament scholar and former Bishop of Durham, whose writings are widely appreciated for their accessible and engaging approach. The book offers daily readings and reflections for the seven weeks of Lent, guiding us to journey with Christ—from his time of testing in the wilderness, through the sorrow of the cross, and onward into the joy of Easter.


